Our Veteran's Books are presented to honour those who, in times of war and peace, gave more than was expected, by doing more than was asked.

While there is no glory in war, there is honour and it is our sincere desire that this memorial honours the memory of one of the many who helped preserve the freedoms that we all enjoy today.

THE BOOK

The Veteran Book is created by using information provided by the family about their loved ones service record.

Included in the book is:

- A service photo of the deceased (or any photo chosen by the family)
- Rank and station of service
- Conflicts served in
- Honours received
- A dedication page for each medal received which includes a photo and description

Additional information can also be included in the book. Many veterans also served on Canadian soil as firefighters, paramedics or police officers and these are all ranks that are equally as honourable.
