SERVICE PRICE LIST

The prices set out in this schedule are effective from **January 1, 2018** and are effective until a new price list is in effect. All of the items marked with an asterisk * will be charged as a minimum charge. This list does not include taxes or prices for additional items which we are asked to purchase for the Purchaser from 3rd party suppliers, such as radio and newspaper notices, clergy honourariums, organist fees or other items and services. These items will be shown as disbursements on our contracts and then with actual cost on the final invoice to the purchaser.

Our Funeral Directors will advise purchasers, at the time arrangements are made, if any legal or other requirements will involve additional supplies or services to be purchased.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

***Co-ordinating Activities, Rites and Ceremonies: \$450.00**

This service includes, but is not limited to, the availability and work done by our Funeral Director on behalf of the purchaser. This would include: co-ordinating and directing any activities, rites, or ceremonies; the services of our staff and agents to arrange the transfer of the body from the place of death; and coordinating and directing the final disposition of remains. It also includes the services of our support staff in preparing contracts, correspondence, placing notices, booking staff, arranging vehicles, coordinating supplies from 3rd part providers, invoicing and other support functions. *Requires Basic Facilities.*

***Documentation: \$200.00**

This charge is for obtaining the necessary information to complete the documentation legally required in connection with the disposition of remains, arranging for the filing of documentation and registration of death and providing 12 copies of our Funeral Director's Proof of Death Certificates. *Requires Utility Vehicle.*

***Regulatory and Environmental Surcharge \$50.00**

This charge includes annual licensing fees paid to the Ontario Board of Funeral Service for the Establishment License and staff Funeral Director's Licences that are required to provide Funeral Services to the public in the province of Ontario. This fee also includes the cost for disposal of non-reusable instruments, cleaning and sanitizing of linens utilized in the preparation of the body and /or recovery and disposal of medical devices from the body.

***Aftercare Specialist No Charge**

This service is part of our commitment to helping families "*Before, During & After*" the funeral. We realize how difficult it may be for families after the death of a loved one. There is still so much that needs to be done and can sometimes be overwhelming. This service is offered to every family we serve. As part of our ongoing care for your family, we will assist with important matters such as completing applications for Canada Pension Benefits, Insurance claims, Workers Compensation issues, Social Insurance, Health Cards, Passports, Pensions as much more. We have developed a guide book that will help your next of kin/executor. Our aftercare specialist will take you through step by step, helping you navigate the road ahead.

STAFF SERVICES

***Basic:** **\$ 200.00**

This service includes, but is not limited to, staffing, cleaning and maintenance of the premises and grounds, office staff and telephone coverage.

***Initial Transfer:** **\$ 225.00**

This service includes the staff required for the transfer of the remains of the deceased from the place of death to the funeral home. It may also include transportation of the remains from one place to another, using a service vehicle, for distances not exceeding 25 km from the Funeral Home. *Requires Service Vehicle/Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/Shelter Remains.*

Extra Transfer Staff assistance when deceased weighs in excess of 400 lbs. **\$ 200.00**

***Basic Preparation:** **\$ 200.00**

These services may include, when necessary, bathing, dressing, cosmetology, basic hairdressing, placement of deceased in casket/container or may include sanitation and exterior disinfection of the body when no embalming is authorized and placement in casket/container. *Requires Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/Shelter Remains. Please note that if family request haircut and/or colouring additional charges will incur.*

Standard Embalming: **\$ 325.00**

Embalming is not a legal requirement within the Province of Ontario (although may be required by an independent shipping carrier. i.e., body is being shipped out-of-province). Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Some funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing, the holding of a body for more than a limited time or other circumstances under which normal decomposition of the body would present us with a practical problem, requires embalming by funeral home policy in which case we will use our professional judgement to determine on a case-by-case basis whether embalming is recommended. *Requires Basic Facilities/Preparation Facilities/Basic Preparations.*

Removal & Disposal of Pacemaker: **\$ 50.00**

The surgical removal of a pacemaker is required prior to cremation. This is a legal requirement by all crematoriums in Ontario.

Division of Cremated Remains: **\$ 50.00**

Professional services of a licensed funeral director to divide cremated remains as requested by a family.

Special Cases and Tissue and/or Organ Procurement Restoration: **\$ 475.00**

Additional restorative services are required when we are embalming and/or during preparation of remains that have had but not limited to a post-mortem examination, infectious or communicable disease and or organ/bone donation. These circumstances require additional labour intensive restorative process and require additional material, equipment and professional services of the licenced funeral director. *Requires Standard Embalming.*

Professional Restoration Services

\$ 60.00 per hour

In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the Standard Embalming and/or the Procurement Restoration procedures are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options and cost with the family.

Initial Period of Visiting: \$ 300.00

This service includes but is not limited to: preparing for a family gathering or public visitation to be held in the afternoon/evening or any part thereof, staffing by our unlicensed funeral assistants during visitation, receiving and arranging floral tributes, coordinating donations and other duties associated with rites and services conducted during visitation. Total of 3 hours of staff time. 1 hour of private family time is included at no extra charge. *Requires Facilities charges.*

Each Subsequent Period of Visiting: \$ 200.00

This service includes all of the services itemized in the description for an Initial Period of Visiting and is charged on a per diem basis. It applies to any family gathering or for the reception of friends and relatives for each subsequent period after the initial period of visiting.

Ceremony Day: \$ 325.00

This service includes but is not limited to: preparations for the ceremony, staff to direct and assist with the ceremony and up to four hours of staff services (afternoon/evening or any part thereof) for services taking place at the Funeral Home or another location (ie. Church). This service would include receiving, arranging, and local delivery of flowers, coordinating donations, etc. *Requires Ceremony Day Facilities. Offsite Ceremonies require transportation charges.*

Additional Staff: \$ 75.00 per hour

Additional staff, as required, to accommodate special requests by family, technical assistance, reception staff or other requests not covered in standard staff services for the visitation, ceremony, interment, extra flower deliveries and/or reception

Sunday and/or Statutory Holidays: \$ 300.00

If visitation or services are requested on a Sunday and/or statutory holiday an additional flat fee will be charged for staff services and facilities.

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

***Basic: \$ 395.00**

This is a minimum charge required in all cases for the use of our facilities including: parking area, areas open to the public within the funeral home, our arrangement office, casket display room and other facilities and equipment required to operate as a licensed funeral home.

***Room for Basic Preparation/Embalming and/or Shelter Remains: \$ 225.00**

This applies whenever the body is in our facility for any purpose. It includes use of all necessary equipment for supervision and professional or sanitary care of the remains in a room specifically for this purpose.

Initial Period of Visitation: \$ 300.00

This includes use of our designated facilities (up to 2 hours in total length, afternoon/evening or any part thereof) for family gathering or for the reception of friends and relatives. It may include any or all of the following: register desk, casket bier, flower and donation stands, standard audio/video system, and religious equipment. *Requires Staff for 1 Day of Gathering or Visiting.*

Each Subsequent Period of Visitation: \$ 200.00

This includes all of the items listed in the description for an Initial Period of Visiting and is charged on a per diem basis. It applies to any family gathering or for the reception of friends and relatives for each subsequent period of use after the initial period of visiting.

Ceremony Day: \$ 325.00

This includes the use of our designated facilities, furnishings and equipment the day of the ceremony or the use of equipment for an off-premise ceremony, such as your church or home. This may include any or all of the following: lectern, organ, standard A/V equipment, religious equipment, flower and donation card display stands, casket bier, photo boards and easels, etc. *Requires Staff for Ceremony Day or Direction of Ceremony in Facility Other Than Funeral Home.*

Custodial Care: \$ 50.00

May be charged after the remains have been sheltered for a period of 48 hours. This is a per diem charge.

Custodial Care - Cremated Remains: \$ 50.00

The funeral home will hold the cremated remains for a period of 30 days at no charge. If the cremated remains are not claimed in the first 30 days, the Purchaser will pay a monthly custodial care – cremated remains fee of \$50.00 per month to be billed on the first day of each month until the date the Purchaser takes possession of the cremated remains. The Funeral Home will retain the cremated remains for a period up to 1 year from the date of the cremation. If the cremated remains are not claimed by the Purchaser within 1 year, the Funeral Home may inter the cremated remains in a cemetery, including in a common lot for which the cemetery is the interment rights holder, and the Funeral Home will bill the family the cost of the interment and storage fees listed above.

TRANSPORTATION

These prices are for the use of each vehicle on a single occasion, such as use of the funeral coach from the funeral home to the church and then cemetery, where the trip does not exceed 30 kilometres from our funeral home. Beyond this area an additional charge may be made for the use of all vehicles for each kilometre travelled from the funeral home at the rate of \$ 2.25 per kilometre,

one way.

***Utility Vehicle: \$ 150.00**

This vehicle is used by our staff in making arrangements, picking up and filing documentation necessary for our services, financial transactions or any other trips that are necessary in conjunction with the services being performed by us. The charge for this vehicle is a flat fee for all funeral services performed by us.

***Service Vehicle: \$ 100.00**

This vehicle is used by our staff for delivery of floral tributes to cemetery, church, or other locations instructed. This vehicle may also be used for delivery of remains to crematoriums, other funeral homes, airports, etc. The charge for this vehicle is a flat fee for all funeral services performed by us.

Funeral Coach: \$ 450.00

This vehicle is used for the transportation of the deceased from our facility to the place of the ceremony and to the place of final disposition. *Requires Staff Ceremony Day*

Lead/Clergy/Cemetery Interment Vehicle: \$ 125.00

This vehicle can be used for any or all of the following: transportation of clergy to Funeral Home and/or place of ceremony, transportation of clergy to place of final disposition, leading of funeral procession, attendance at cemetery/mausoleum for interment/inurnment. *Requires Staff Ceremony Day*

Additional Vehicles \$ 100.00

Additional vehicles, as required, to transport to the crematorium, to accommodate special requests by family, pallbearers, family car or other requests not covered under standard equipment and & vehicles for the visitation, ceremony, interment and/or reception.

PAYMENT POLICY

Payment in full is due by the specified date on the contract (the "Due Date"). While payment is due prior to the day of the funeral, a 30-day interest-free grace period is offered for the collection of insurance or other necessary banking arrangements. A service charge equal to 3% of the total Services and Supplies will be added to the unpaid balance on the day after the 30 day grace period. After 60 days, interest will be charged on overdue amounts at a rate of 2% per month or 24% per annum, calculated monthly, until the date of payment in full. We require a deposit prior to providing merchandise and services. Your funeral director requires the payment of cash disbursements prior to the day of the funeral; i.e. flowers, newspaper notices, clergy, musicians etc. It is our intention to assist you in any way we are able with these financial arrangements and any other matters. It is not our policy to wait for payments from an estate. There will be a charge of \$25.00 for any non-sufficient funds (NSF) cheques returned by the bank. Any costs of collection shall be the responsibility of the Purchaser. It is the policy of the Funeral Home that Visa or MasterCard may be used at the time of purchase but may not be used if payment is made after services and supplies are provided.
